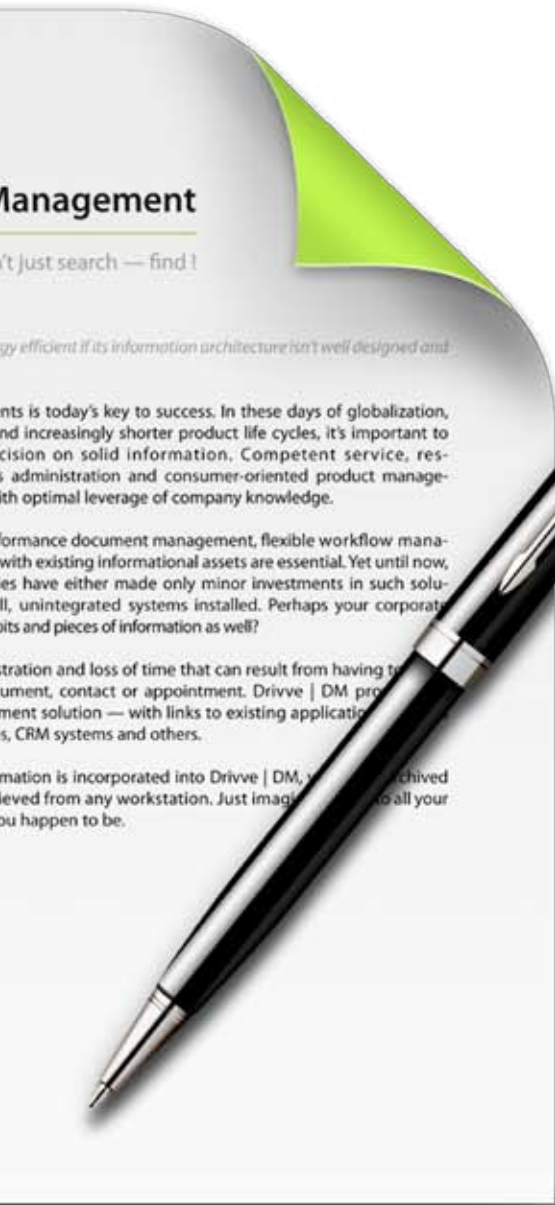
It's simple. Your office won't be energy efficient if its information architecture isn't well designed and 100% integrated.

With relational databases, backing up your archive means having to recopy the entire disc image, over and over again. This often takes an inordinate amount of time and doesn't come without significant risk of data loss. Our approach is so much more efficient and secure that it's almost too good to be true — but it is. What's the big secret? It has to do with the fact that our container-based solution can back the vault up *incrementally*, which means that you copy *only* the newly created data to the backup disc, one step at a time. With this approach, performing a full backup of a Live Archive™ containing several terabytes of information (that's millions of docs) can be done in minutes. How long does it take a relational database to back up that much info? You don't even want to ask.

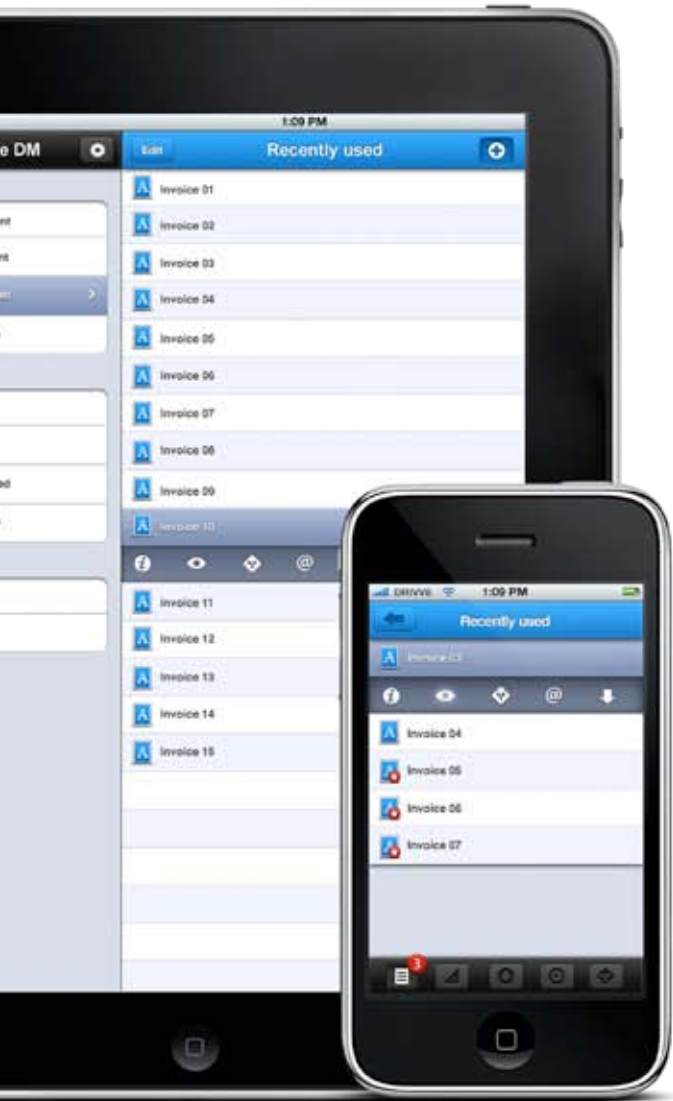

With basic document retrieval, the user specifies a unique document identifier that the system index uses to locate the document. With more flexible retrieval, the user specifies partial search terms using the document identifier and/or parts of the expected metadata and the system returns a list of matching documents.

Drivve | DM lets you specify a Boolean expression containing multiple keywords or phrases that you'd expect to exist within a document's content. Retrieval for this kind of query may be supported by previously built indexes, otherwise full-text searches of all documents returns a list of those that are potentially relevant.
